Well I had had them for 59 years with no problem. Two weeks before all this started I had an iodine water based dye for an enhanced CT scan, admittedly intravenous but it does make you wonder when nobody knows why this happened to me!!9

We need someone who has had similar symptoms when being given these uptodate waterbased dyes because in 1995 the Royal College of Radiologists, at the height of the Myodil scandal admitted that waterbased dyes had more iodine than Myodil ever had!
